January 17, 2007: SD becomes Mayor when O'Malley becomes Governor.

September 11, 2007: SD wins Democratic primary with 63% of the vote.

December 4, 2007: SD is sworn in as Mayor.

June 17, 2008: SD's home raided by Maryland State Procecutor's office.

January 9, 2009: SD indicted on 12 charges.

December 1, 2009: SD convicted of misdemeanor embezzlement. Trial for perjury still pending.

January 6, 2010: SD signs plea agreement, agrees to plead guilty to perjury and resigns.

February 4, 2010: SD leaves office, begins 4 years of probation during which she cannot run for office.
