Please ask Councilman Jones
to introduce legislation – as soon as possible!
– that limits the size of individual stores on the
Owings Mills Mall property to 60,000 SF.

This limit is consistent with the current Kimco site plan for the property.

More importantly, a reasonable store size limit prevents Kimco from anchoring its Mall property with a new Walmart Supercenter.

A new Supercenter on the Mall property will result in the closing of the Liberty Road Walmart Supercenter and the Reisterstown Road Walmart – and quite possibly many other smaller businesses that depend upon the traffic these Walmarts help generate.

Kimco has every right to make a profit, just not at the expense of established retail centers in our community.

Kimco needs to come up with a better plan for its Mall property – a plan that doesn't include a new Walmart Supercenter.

If Kimco anchors its Owings Mills Town Center with a new Walmart Supercenter,

Walmart is going to close both its Liberty Road Supercenter and its store on Reisterstown Road.

"Dark Stores" are bad for our local economy and families.

We can avoid the "urban blight" that results when Walmart closes stores.
